Election Commission plans pan-India special revision of electoral rolls, to begin with poll-bound states

NEW DELHI, OCT 10


The Election Commission is likely to roll out pan-India special intensive revision of voters' list in phases beginning with a group of states, including those where assembly polls are due next year, officials said.

At the same time, it will not hold the electoral roll cleanup exercise in states where local body elections are taking place or are due, as the grass roots poll machinery is busy with it and may not be able to focus on Puducherry, Tamil Nadu and Election Commission. West Bengal are due in 2026.
